Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund – II (HEERF II)
Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students

Mitchell's Academy has signed and returned the certification and agreement form to receive the allocated portion of the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF). The institution will use these HEERF funds of \$54,619 to provide emergency financial grants to students.

Institutions must make financial aid grants to students, which can be used for any component of the student's total cost of attendance, or for emergency costs arising due to coronavirus. Unlike the CARES Act, the HEERF II **requires that institutions prioritize students with exceptional need**, such as students who receive Pell Grants. However, students do not need to be only Pell Grant recipients to qualify for a HEERF II grant.

Eligibility Requirements to Receive a HEERF II Grant

- Student must be enrolled in a Title IV eligible program
- Enrolled during 7/1/2020-6/30/2021
- US citizen or an eligible non-citizen
